## K. Wah International Holdings Ltd. to launch Johnston Road project – "J Residence" soon

Wah International Holdings Limited ("KWIH" or "Group", stock code: 173) announced that its new residential project located on Johnston Road, Admiralty, has been formally named the "J Residence". It is the first development project in Hong Kong that integrates heritage conservation with new residential development.

Demonstrating its innovative spirit and constant quest to advance with time, KWIH has worked with the Urban Renewal Authority to develop the metropolitan project that comprises serviced apartments, and stylish dining and entertainment facilities, adding a new icon to the city.
